

Agricultural Scout Cranberry Production

The Club Environnemental et Technique Atocas Québec **(CETAQ)** is a non-profit focused on advising cranberry growers to help them implement good agricultural practices.

CETAQ offers a variety of services: integrated pest management, fertilization programs, equipment calibration, etc.

It's located in <u>Lourdes, Québec, Canada</u> and offer services to 60 cranberry growers of the Centredu-Québec region.

Main tasks

- a. Identify phenological stages of cranberry throughout the season;
- b. Observe and describe the general state of the fields;
- c. Scout to identify and count pests (mainly lepidopterans and coleopterans);
- d. Compile and communicate scouting data to growers and agronomists;
- e. Coordinate and discuss with supervisors regarding schedules and data

A full training is provided.

Requirements

- a. Training or interests in biology, agronomy, agriculture, environment, etc.;
- b. Good physical condition;
- c. Observational skills and attention to details;
- d. Autonomy and initiative;
- e. Aptitude for both individual and teamwork.
- f. Bonus to have : a car and a driving permit

Working conditions

- 35 hours/week at 19,00\$/h variable according to the weather;
- Car usage reimbursed according to fuel prices;
- Travel allowance of 20\$/day worked;
- Starting May 1st until July 28th (13 weeks), with some possibilities afterward too.

There is housing nearby CETAQ.
